The **5th Findhorn Bay Festival** will present a spectacular celebration of arts and culture, radiating from the heart of Moray and takes place across the Findhorn bay area and beyond in the towns, villages and communities which make up our region – all of which will host well renowned, high quality international and Scottish artists, creators and performers.

The next Festival will take place from 20-29
September 2024. Audiences will be invited to become cultural explorers and experience work set in unexpected spaces and scenic locations in the rural and coastal towns and villages of Moray

The Festival builds upon the high levels of success and engagement seen in previous years and will provide audiences with the very best in cultural experiences, ensuring a diverse and vibrant mix of theatre and performance, exhibitions, live music, fine-art and photography, talks, tours and free family friendly events for all to enjoy.

Our Impact

In 2022, the 4th Findhorn Bay Festival delivered:

- Over 90 ticketed and free events across 10 days.
- 281 individual artists and creative practitioners.
- 11,061 attendances across free and ticketed events and activities.
- Employment of 327 creative professionals and artists.
- Support from over 40 programme, community and business partners.
- Participation from over 898 people, including 69 volunteers.
- Media and advertising campaign reaching over 18m people.
- Estimated £987,948 in local economic benefit.

To deliver the Festival, producer Findhorn Bay Arts developed a range of working partnerships, collaborating with funders, business sponsors, local hospitality businesses, community groups, cultural organisations, third sector groups, heritage organisations, venues, schools, local artists, event management and production teams, and a team of volunteers largely drawn from the local community.
